New La Pine Dining and Entertainment Venue Opening this Summer

Kodiak Malmstrom, along with partners Lisa Mendoza and Corey LaChapelle, owners of La Pine's Air Tech Heating & Cooling are working on the project in La Pine.

Describing the enterprise as "café meets live music venue meets tap house," Malmstrom said that "we'll have a little bit of everything for everybody, a place where working people can bring their families."
In addition to four food trucks – serving BBQ, pizza, chicken, and other options –

Malmstrom's plans include constructing a



1,500-square-foot outdoor pavilion that is 17 feet high with a six-foot interior firepit; and converting a former grain silo into a live music venue, with 10' x 20' doors opening into it. Inside the primary building, there will be wi-fi, 20 beer taps on the wall, bench seating as well as tables and chairs, three TV sets ("for sporting events such as the Kentucky Derby, PPV fights, and football games, to name a few"), an ADA bar, and several options for wine and mixed drinks. "With occupancy north of 150 patrons, the venue will take advantage of the million-dollar view of the Cascade Mountains. We're also creating 20 parking spots on both paved and resurfaced ground, and having ADA-compliant bathrooms inside and outside," Malmstrom said. "I envision a gathering place where people can play games such as horseshoes, beanbag toss, and Zenga, and – because we'll be open 365 days a year – participate in activities such as chainsaw carving, igloo building, and ice sculpting." he promised.

Permitting Activity in South Deschutes County

Deschutes County issued 114 building permits in La Pine for the 2nd quarter of 2022. Of those, 33 were for single-family dwellings, 8 for new commercial buildings, and 1 for a commercial building alteration.



During the same period, in the rest of South Deschutes County, 890 building permits were issued. Of those, 46 were for single-family dwellings, 5 for new commercial buildings, and 4 for commercial building alterations.



Funding for the SLED program comes from both public and private members and stakeholders. The City of La Pine and Deschutes County are key partners and contributors, as well as private businesses from around the County and Central Oregon that wish to support a stronger and more vibrant economy in South Deschutes County. Over the past six years, SLED has assisted 11 new and existing businesses with capital investments of more than \$11.6 million, resulting in the creation of 135 jobs.
